

**Specific terms for the U.S. market**

This engine is certified as being in conformity with Federal and California emission control regulations. The emissions control parts are covered by the Emission Control System Warranty. Covered parts and conditions are listed under "What is covered by the Emission Warranty" in the "Emission Control System Warranty Statement". Repairs and service covered by the warranty will be performed by an authorized Volvo Penta distributor or dealer with no charge for parts or labor, including diagnosis, using Volvo Penta parts for any part of the emission control system covered by the warranty and found defective.

Use of a service or repair facility that is not a Volvo Penta authorized distributor or dealer, or use of non-Volvo Penta emission-related components, will not void or limit coverage of the Emission Control System Warranty. If emission related components/items are included in the scheduled service, then such parts are marked in the service protocol with a diamond (♦) and the service must be performed at prescribed time intervals for compliance with the Emission Control System Warranty.
